Application Fee (per family): \$200 per family (\$150 Application/Enrollment Fee + \$50 Testing Fee)

Zone 1: North to 159th (Illinois)/165th(Indiana); South to Glenwood-Lansing Road/45th Street; West to I-94/394; East to Indianapolis Blvd

Zone 2: To the south, between Glenwood-Lansing and US 30; to the west between 394 and Halsted; to the north between 159th/165th and Sibley Blvd

Zone 3: To the south, between US 30 and Steger Rd west to Cottage Grove; to the southwest, area between Glenwood-Dyer/Main, Joe Orr Rd, Halsted, and Center; to the northwest, areas to the north of 159th and west of I-94; to the north, areas north of Sibley Blvd and east of I-94

Statements of Belief and Purposes

Lansing Christian School has been established and maintained by an association of parents who believe that it is their duty as Christians to provide Christian education for their children and, believing that this can best be accomplished by concerted action, are committed to Christian training for their children in keeping with the teachings of the Holy Word of God.

_____ We believe that God exists in three persons; namely, God the Father who is creator and sustainer of the universe; Jesus Christ, the Father's only begotten Son, who was sent into the world to save sinners who believe in Him and who now rules as King of the holy catholic (universal) church; and the Holy Spirit who was sent as the Christian's comforter, sanctifier and guide.

_____ We believe that the Holy Bible is the only infallible and inspired Word of God and that it must be taught and used as the guide for the Christian life, conduct and education.

_____ We believe that the Word of God requires Christian parents to make every effort to train their children in the fear and nurture of the Lord and that for this reason the instruction of children in the school, as well as in the home, must be in keeping with the teachings of the Word of God. We believe that we must educate children so that they can become useful servants of their God in His Kingdom and that they can serve as useful citizens of the society in which they live.

_____ We believe that the primary responsibility to train children belongs to parents and that our school depends on and belongs to parents. It does not depend on or belong to the church or state, but has as its foundation the unchangeable Word of God, interpreted according to the historic creeds of the Calvinistic churches.

_____ We believe we must help our students understand that God summons them to honest worship, moral discipline, and personal holiness and that we must equip them for meaningful service in the kingdom of God.
