

## SCHOOL SUPPLIES NEEDED BY STUDENTS 2016/2017

**PreK** – Backpack, Box of facial tissues, package of baby wipes, paint shirt (a large size old t-shirt), 8 count Crayola crayons (not larger)

**Kindergarten** – Each student is asked to bring the following shared supplies: 24 - #2 pencils, 1 pink school eraser, 4 fine point dry-erase markers, 1 box of facial tissues, and 1 box of baby wipes. For personal use: 1 pencil box, 1 scissors, 2 – 4 oz. bottle of Elmer's glue, 3 glue sticks, 2 packs of Crayola crayons (24 count), 2 folders and a backpack.

**First Grade** – Each student is asked to bring the following *shared* supplies: 24 (#2 yellow-not recycled) pencils, 2 boxes of crayons (24 count), 2 pink school erasers, 2 bottles of Elmer's glue (4 oz.), 8-10 glue sticks, 2 dry erase markers, and 1 large box of facial tissues. For *personal* use: scissors (sharp point), 2 folders, 12-inch ruler (including cm.). No school box is needed.

**Second Grade** – Same as grade one with the following additions: 2 highlighters (any color), a 70 count wide-ruled spiral notebook, 2 boxes of colored pencils (12 ct.). No school box is needed.

**Third Grade** – 24 - #2 Pencils, crayons, colored pencils, 1 dry erase marker, white school glue, 2 glue sticks, erasers, scissors (sharp pointed), 12" ruler with inches and centimeters, loose leaf notebook paper (wide lined), 3 pocket folders, one-1" 3-ring binder, one spiral notebook (8 ½ x 11, 70 pgs.), school box (8½x5½x½ size), one regular box of facial tissues.

**Fourth Grade** – Pencils, crayons, colored pencils, erasers, two large glue sticks, glue bottle, 12" ruler with inches and centimeters, wide-lined notebook paper, ink pens, two 70-page spiral notebooks, 3 pocket folders, dry erase marker, black sharpie, scissors, a small assignment notebook, and one regular box of facial tissues.

**A student planner will be provided for each student in grades 5-8.** All students will have the same planner so it is not necessary for parents to purchase an additional planner.

**Fifth Grade** – Crayons (no markers), colored pencils for map work, one highlighter (any color) pencils with erasers on the end, eraser, scissors, one glue stick, one bottle school glue, ruler with inches and centimeters, one black dry-erase marker, white notebook paper (no narrow lines), ballpoint pen (black or blue ink), 3 spiral notebooks (8 ½ x 11, 70 pg.) - one each for language arts, science, and math; 7 pocket folders – one each used for social studies, English, math, science, Bible, one for storing notebook paper and for take-home papers; and one or two regular boxes of facial tissues. A trapper/binder can be helpful for organizing materials, but is optional.

**Sixth Grade** – A package of white notebook paper with regular width lines (no narrow lines), 3 spiral notebooks with regular lines, 7 pocket folders (these should have holes in them so they fit into the students' trappers), pencils and eraser, red or colored pens, colored pencils, scissors, ruler with inches and centimeters, 2 glue sticks, 2 dry erase markers (any color), an inexpensive calculator, and one box of facial tissues. **Seventh Grade** – Colored pencils, lead pencils, 3 pens (black or blue ink), 2 red marking pens, scissors, metric ruler, a package of lined notebook paper, 6 spiral notebooks for notes, 7 pocket folders for assignments (includes 1 for Spanish), glue, eraser, book covers for math, grammar, literature, and social studies books (can be paper grocery bags or store-bought covers, three large, one small), a basic calculator with a square root key ( $\sqrt{\quad}$ ) for math, a box of facial tissues. Students will purchase a PE shirt through the teacher the first week of school.

**Eighth Grade** – List is the same as seventh grade. A scientific calculator similar to the TI-30XA is recommended for math, although a basic calculator with square root function will suffice.
