

## **SCHOOL SUPPLIES NEEDED BY STUDENTS 2021-2022**

**PreK** – Backpack, 2 boxes of facial tissues, 2 package of baby wipes, paint shirt (a large size old t-shirt), 2-24 count Crayola crayons (not larger), 2 Crayola watercolor paint with brush 8 count, 1 bottle of Elmers 4 oz. liquid glue, and 1 package of Crayola washable markers (10 pack).

**Kindergarten/English** - Each student is asked to bring the following *shared* supplies: 24 - #2 pencils, 2 pink school erasers, 8 fine point dry-erase markers, 2 boxes of facial tissues, and 2 boxes of baby wipes. For *personal* use: 1 pencil box, 1 scissors, 2 – 4 oz. bottle of Elmer’s glue, 3 glue sticks, 2 packs of Crayola crayons (24 count), 1 pack of Crayola markers, 2 folders and a backpack.

**Kindergarten/Spanish** - Each student is asked to bring the following *shared* supplies: 24 - #2 pencils, 2 pink school erasers, 8 fine point dry-erase markers, 2 boxes of facial tissues, and 2 boxes of baby wipes. For *personal* use: 1 pencil box, 1 scissors, 2 – 4 oz. bottle of Elmer’s glue, 3 glue sticks, 2 packs of Crayola crayons (24 count), 2 folders and a backpack.

**First Grade/English** – Each student is asked to bring the following *shared* supplies: 24 (#2 yellow-not recycled) pencils, 3 boxes of crayons (24 count), 2 pink school erasers, 2 bottles of Elmer’s glue (4 oz.), 8-10 glue sticks, 1 container of disinfecting wipes, and 1 large box of facial tissues. For *personal* use: scissors (sharp point), 1 folder, and 1 spiral notebook. No school box is needed.

**First Grade/Spanish** – Each student is asked to bring the following *shared* supplies: 24 (#2 yellow-not recycled) sharpened pencils, 2 boxes of crayons (24 count), 2 pink school erasers, 2 bottles of Elmer’s glue (4 oz.), 8-10 glue sticks, 4 fine point dry erase markers, 2 chisel tip dry erase markers, 1 container of disinfecting wipes, and 1 large box of facial tissues. For *personal* use: scissors (sharp point), 1 box of colored pencils (24 count), 1 composition book, and 2 folders. No school box is needed.

**Second Grade/English** – Each student is asked to bring the following *shared* supplies: 24 (#2 yellow-not recycled) pencils, 3 boxes of crayons (24 count), 2 pink school erasers, 2 bottles of Elmer’s glue (4 oz.), 8 dry erase markers, 2 containers of disinfecting wipes, and 1 large box of facial tissues. For *personal* use: scissors (sharp point), 2 folders, 12-inch ruler (including cm.), 2 highlighters (any color), a 70 count wide ruled spiral notebook, 2 boxes of colored pencils (12 ct.). No school box is needed.

**Second Grade/Spanish** – Each student is asked to bring the following *shared* supplies: 24 (#2 yellow-not recycled) pencils, 3 boxes of crayons (24 count), 2 pink school erasers, 2 bottles of Elmer’s glue (4 oz.), 8-10 glue sticks, 4 dry erase markers, 2 containers of disinfecting wipes, and 1 large box of facial tissues. For *personal* use: scissors (sharp point), 2 folders, 12-inch ruler (including cm.), 2 highlighters (any color), a 70 count wide ruled spiral notebook, 1 steno notepad, 1 composition notebook, and 2 boxes of colored pencils (12 ct.). One school box is needed.

**Third Grade/English** – 24 - #2 Pencils (not mechanical), crayons, colored pencils, 1 dry erase marker, white school glue, 2 glue sticks, erasers, scissors (sharp pointed), 12” ruler with inches and centimeters, loose leaf notebook paper (wide lined), 3 pocket folders (no prongs), one-1” 3-ring binder, one spiral notebook (8 ½ x 11, 70 pgs.), school box (8½x5½x½ size), one regular box of facial tissues, and 1 package of Lysol wipes.

**Third Grade/Spanish** – Headphones, 2 highlighters (any color), 1 black sharpie, 24 - #2 Pencils (not mechanical, not recycled), 24 count crayons, colored pencils, 1 dry erase marker, white school glue, 2 glue sticks, 2 erasers (large, pink), scissors (sharp pointed), 12” ruler with inches and centimeters, 3 pocket folders (no prongs), one-1” 3-ring binder, school box (8½x5½x½ size), 2 containers of disinfecting wipes (Lysol or Clorox), 1 regular box of facial tissues, and 1 package of baby wipes

**Fourth Grade/English** – Pencils, crayons, colored pencils, erasers, two large glue sticks, glue bottle, 12” ruler with inches and centimeters, wide-lined notebook paper, ink pens, two 70-page spiral notebooks, 3 pocket folders, dry erase marker, black sharpie, scissors, and one regular box of facial tissues.

**Fourth Grade/Spanish** - Pencils, crayons, colored pencils, erasers, two large glue sticks, glue bottle, 12” ruler with inches and centimeters, clear protractor, inexpensive ear buds, wide-lined notebook paper, 1 sticky notes, ink pens, two 70-page spiral notebooks, 3 pocket folders, 4 dry erase markers, 1 old sock to be used as whiteboard eraser, black sharpie, scissors, 1 pencil box or pouch, 1 package of disinfecting wipes, and one regular box of facial tissues.

**A student planner will be provided for each student in grades 4-8.** All students will have the same planner so it is not necessary for parents to purchase an additional planner.

**Fifth Grade** – Colored pencils, pencil pouch case, 24 pencils, eraser, scissors, 4 glue sticks, rules with inches and centimeters, 2 ballpoint pens (red ink), 4 dry erase markers, 4 spiral notebooks (8 ½ x 11, 70 pg.), 5-pocket Expandable filing folder; Earbuds (for Chromebook), 1 Composition book (standard 100 page), and two regular boxes of facial tissues. A trapper/binder can be helpful for organizing materials, but is optional.

**Sixth/Seventh/Eighth Grade** – A package of white notebook paper with regular width lines (no narrow lines), 6 spiral notebooks with regular lines, 1 composition notebook for labs, 7 pocket folders (these should have holes in them so they fit into the students’ trappers), pencils and eraser, 3 pens (black or blue ink), 3 red pens, colored pencils, scissors, ruler with inches and centimeters, 2 dry erase markers (any color, 6<sup>th</sup> grade only), 4 glue sticks (6<sup>th</sup> grade only), and 2 boxes of facial tissues. A scientific calculator similar to the TI-30XA is recommended for math although a basic calculator with a square root key (√) will suffice. Students will purchase a PE shirt for \$10.00 through the teacher the first week of school if they don’t have one already. Please have deodorant, fingertip length shorts, and a pair of running shoes that you can wear for PE class. Earbuds with microphone to stay with homeroom teacher.
